ZENYATTA broke slowly, settled a bit off the rail then chased three deep on the backstretch, advanced four wide midway on the second turn, ranged up outside a rival into the stretch, took the lead alongside the pacesetter in midstretch, was mildly ridden along for a few strides to clear and proved best under a long hold. QUITE A STORMKAT sped to the early lead, angled in and set a pressured pace inside, inched clear on the second turn, was no match for the winner in the final furlong and just held second. DOWN chased a bit off the rail, split rivals on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and just missed the place. CARESSIVE stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, found the inside on the second turn and lacked the needed late kick. READY MAID between foes early, stalked three deep, fell back some on the second turn and lacked a response in the stretch. SCARLET LOVE tracked the pace along the inside, dropped back on the backstretch and second turn and weakened. OAKHILL GIRL three deep early, prompted the pace outside the runner-up, fell back on the second turn and also weakened.
